**Bogor, June 17 2008** – PT Antam Tbk (ASX - ATM; IDX - ANTM), today distributed Rp2.35 billion worth of funds in the form of scholarships for 1.000 students, donation to build a high school and funds for a Partnership Program, in Pongkor, Nanggung District, Bogor, the location of Antam's Gold Mining Business Unit.
