ANTAM LAUNCHES ENGLISH TRAINING PROGRAM FOR UNIVERSITY LECTURERS AND STUDENTS IN NORTH MALUKU

The opening ceremony was conducted on Monday, March 5th, 2012 by Antam's Director of CSR and General Affairs, Denny Maulasa. Also present at the launch were, among others, the Rector of the University of Khairun, Gufran Ali Ibrahim, and Vice Rector III of the University of Muhammadiyah of North Maluku, Sofyan Abbas.
