ANTAM SENDS AIDS TO FLOOD VICTIMS IN JAKARTA

Jakarta, February 5th, 2007 – PT Antam Tbk (ASX - ATM; JSX, SSX - ANTM) announces it has sent voluntary relief teams and logistics to aid people affected by the flood in Jakarta. Antam's voluntary relief teams will assist people at Pasar Minggu, Kalibata, Tebet, Cipinang, and Cileduk.

Since Friday, February 2nd, 2007, Antam has donated tents to shelter homeless victims, rubber boats for evacuation, medicine, food, drinking water, and lamps through relief posts set up by Antam's voluntary teams. Antam's budget for the relief effort is Rp1 billion.

The voluntary teams continue to identify the most essential logistics and help evacuation and rehabilitative efforts. Antam's voluntary relief teams consist of its employees as well as their families.
