CENTER AT BOGOR

**Jakarta, December 16, 2013** - PT ANTAM (Persero) Tbk (ASX - ATM; IDX - ANTM; Antam) is pleased to announce the launching of the fruit center program at the Nanggung district of Bogor regency. The launching was officially marked with tree planting ceremony by Antam's General Affairs and CSR Director, Denny Maulasa and the Regent of Bogor, Rachmat Yasin on January 15, 2013.

The development of the fruit center is part of Antam's Corporate Social Responsibility program to empower the economy of local communities as well as to preserve the natural conservation in the surrounding area of Antam's gold mine at Pongkor, West Java.

During its initial phase, Antam has planted 25,000 fruit trees in 2012 in the villages of Malasari, Cisarua and Bantar Karet, all located at the Nanggung district, Bogor regency.

Antam's fruit center development program is conducted in cooperation with the Quantum Institute of Management (QIM). QIM has the expertise in the field of community development and planting of fruit plants. QIM will assist local communities in the planting, caring for and harvesting of fruit trees.

The fruit trees include Mangosteen (*Garcinia mangostana*), Avocado (*Persea Americana*), Crystal Guava (*Psidium guajava*) and Malay apple (*Syzygium malaccense*). The selection of the fruit is based on the environmental condition at Nanggung. Antam plans to increase the fruit trees and planting area as well as the involvement of local communities.
